

Washington, D.C. – Congressman Jeff Fortenberry, chairman of the House Agriculture Committee's Operations, Oversight, and Credit Subcommittee, announced that he will cosponsor the sodsaver provision that is anticipated to be brought up in today's Farm Bill markup.
